 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN A. LINDSTROM
 1805 SOUTHGATE PL
 PENDLETON OR 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 2.25 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1894 FOR 1.31 ACRES AND 1907 FOR 0.94 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent), subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 1, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 528, approving Transfer Application 6699, and together with Certificate 72441, supersedes Certificate 53297, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
