CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CASCADE RANCH
380 LAKE CREEK LOOP RD
EAGLE POINT OR 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of LOST, HARRISON, CHARLEY AND COON CREEKS, AND 513.30 ACRE FEET FROM BRADSHAW RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-4747, tributaries of the SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 288.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 913.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31268. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 12.34 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from April 2 to October 31 from direct flow and storage.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the rate described on Certificate 86701. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 86701 and describes that portion of the water right Certificate 83349 NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 29, 2010, and recorded at Volume 83, Pages 123-127, approving Transfer Application T-11117.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
