CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN DUNLAP and SANDRA BRUGGE  
1744 PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD  
MERLIN, OREGON 97532

confirms the right to use the waters of JUMPOFF JOE CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.2 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1893.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 19, 1986, at Special Order Volume 40, Page 357, approving Transfer Application 5827, and supersedes Certificate 48721, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
