CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ERIC AND LYNDA E. STROM

HUBBARD OR 97032

confirms the right to use the waters of PUDDING RIVER, tributary to MOLALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 25.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13550. The date of priority is APRIL 4, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.315 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 15, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 95, approving Transfer Application 9868, and together with Certificate 85960, supersedes Certificate 16648, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
