CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. L. BURK
MYRTLE CREEK, OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, a tributary to MYRTLE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 3.31 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5877. The date of priority is MAY 12, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

29 S	4 W	WM	8	NE NW

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct scrivener's errors in acreage and rate described in Certificate 85967. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 85967, and describes the portion of water right Certificate 83457, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 19, 2010, and recorded at Volume 80, Page 307, approving Transfer Applications T-7820 and T-8453.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
