CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ADAPS LLC

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, within the CHAMPOEG CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 135.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3875. The date of priority is OCTOBER 23, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.03 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 26, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 363, approving Transfer Application 10711, and supersedes Certificate 54709, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
