CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LARRY K. & BARBARA J. SHARPF  
3730 TURNBRIDGE WELLS  
SALEM OR 97302

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the WYCHUS CREEK (formerly Squaw Creek) BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 73.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7092. The date of priority is DECEMBER 26, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.916 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right described by Certificate 86162, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 28 2011, and recorded at Special Order Volume 85, Pages 473, approving Transfer Application T-10900.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
