CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WHYCHUS CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 14.50 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit E-176 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon and made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem in Volume 1 at page 284. The date of priority is October 7, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device(s) for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right described by Certificate 85388, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 28 2011, and recorded at Special Order Volume 85, Pages 469, approving Transfer Application T-10907.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
