confirms the right to use the waters of WHYCHUS CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 48.30 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, Page 471. The date of priority is 1908. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.966 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:
