confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 6, in the UMATILLA BASIN for MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10418. The date of priority is AUGUST 15, 1984. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.74 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, limited to 177.6 acre feet of water per year, if available at the original well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in TYPE OF USE, PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 23, 1990, at Special Order Volume 44, Page 134, approving Transfer Application 6318, supercedes Certificate 62222, State record of Water Right Certificates.
