CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 3 AND WELL 6, in the UMATILLA BASIN for MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-763. The date of priority is February 5, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.23 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of appropriation (well 6), together with that diverted at the old point(s) of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point(s) of appropriation (well 3).


When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 10, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 254, approving Transfer Application 6412, supercedes Certificate 24702, State record of Water Right Certificates.
