confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER, tributary to WALLA WALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 3.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1878.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES per acre (0.135 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 6, 2008, at Special Order Volume 75, Page 108, approving Transfer Application 10418, and together with Certificate 84124, supersedes Certificate 13259, State record of Water Right Certificates.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
