 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TRI CITY WATER DISTRICT  
 215 NORTH OLD PACIFIC HIGHWAY  
 MYRTLE CREEK, OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24600. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion and shall be further limited to a total annual duty of 68.5 acre-feet.

Diversion of water for Quasi-Municipal use under this right shall be limited to the irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion, place of use, and character of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 9, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 578, approving Transfer Applications 9264 and 8911, and supersedes Certificate 76021, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
