CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the PUDDING RIVER, a tributary to the MOLALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 53.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13550. The date of priority is APRIL 4, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.667 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the original point of diversion (SW¼ NE¼, Section 36, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.).

The point of diversion is located as follows:

4 S	1 W	WM	36	NW NE	210 FEET SOUTH AND 190 FEET EAST FROM THE N¼ CORNER OF SECTION 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered 12-1-11, approving Transfer Application T-11237, and supersedes Certificate 85960, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
