CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VICKY S. NEWFIELD
601 DAVIS PLACE RD
MOUNT SHASTA CA 96067

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 1.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20139. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.023 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of diversion described as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at the point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in the POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 30, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 849, approving Transfer Application 10852, and together with Certificate 86218, supersedes Certificate 79477, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
