THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-17167. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1946. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed:

Reach	Instream Rates
Reach #1	0.11 Cubic Foot per Second (CFS)
Reach #2	0.05 CFS

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, during the period July 1 through October 15.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

Reach #2: From immediately below the authorized point of diversion to Lake Billy Chinook.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.34I or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to beneficial use in the place of use described and is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 22454, and any related decree.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
