CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RONALD T. WILLIAMS

KLAMATH FALLS, OR 97601

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED INTERMITTENT FLOW CHANNELS, tributaries of LOST RIVER for IRRIGATION of 27.0 ACRES and STOCK USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-26405. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); being 0.67 cfs for Irrigation and 0.02 cfs for stock use, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 83670, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT transferred by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 21 2011, approving Transfer Application T-10425 for a change in character of use and place of use. This certificate includes modifications to the description of the sources of water as clarified under the provisions of the order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
