CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PINE MEADOWS RANCH INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of HAMMOND WELL, in the WHYCHUS CREEK (FORMERLY KNOWN AS SQUAW CREEK) BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 68.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-581. The date of priority is SEPTMEBER 9, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

15 S	10 E	WM	8	SW NE	390 FEET NORTH & 1500 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in the PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 30, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 430, approving Transfer Application T-7750, and together with Certificate 75617, supersedes Certificate 24584, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
