CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES AND BETTY DUNN  
9695 NW LOWER BRIDGE WAY  
TERREBONNE OR 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19418. The date of priority is MAY 15, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.036 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The period of allowed use is only during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 13, 1985, at Special Order Volume 39, Page 288, approving Transfer Application 5647, and together with Certificate 53612, supersedes Certificate 24637, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
