## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. H. and E. V. ANDERSON DREWSEY OR 97904

confirms the right to use the waters of CALAMITY CREEK, tributary to WOLF CREEK for IRRIGATION of 497.0 acres; being 119.0 ACRES of (priority date 1884) and 378.0 acres (priority date 1890).

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Harney County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 228. The dates of priority are 1884 and 1890.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 1½ acre feet per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, 1.0 acre foot per acre in any 30 day period after June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, or 3.0 acre feet per acre during any season diverted at a rate of not to exceed ONE-TWENTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Prior to October 1, 2013, the water user shall install and maintain Weirs, Parshall Flumes, Submerged Orifices, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the points of diversion. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Prior to October 1, 2015, the water user shall install fish screening, at the historic point of diversion (New #3), consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen meets ODFW's criteria. The water user may withdraw water at the historic point of diversion without screening until October 1, 2015. The water user must obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screening was installed to the state's criteria. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 2 1 2011, approving Transfer Application T- 11192, and supersedes Certificate 6851, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
