Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of FIFTEENMILE CREEK, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 6.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42252. The date of priority is JUNE 13, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.085 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

1 S	13 E	WM	26	SW SW	1470 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 35

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 5, 1986, approving Transfer Application 5691, at Special Order Volume 40, Page 59, approving Transfer 5691, and together with Certificate 87356, supersedes Certificate 50114.

The right to use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
