confirms the right to store the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to DAVIS CREEK in SPENCER RESERVOIR 1, appropriated under Permit S-45328 and Permit S-54312 for IRRIGATION, FROST PROTECTION, AND TEMPERATURE CONTROL (HEAT PROTECTION).

This right was perfected under Permit R-8204. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 6.0 ACRE FEET (AF), BEING 2.5 AF FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL (HEAT PROTECTION), 3.0 AF FOR IRRIGATION, AND 0.5 AF FOR FROST PROTECTION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The dam and point of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water stored. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 2, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 335, approving Transfer Application 6454, and supersedes Certificate 62381, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
