CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 29.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7183. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 25, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) from WELL 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate, together with Certificate 87368 and Certificate 87374, describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79889, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Applications T-11254, T-11255 and T-11256, entered _______ JAN 0 5 2012 ______, and recorded at Special Order Volume 85, Pages 859 to 870.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
