CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS, in the WILLAMETTE BASIN for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9890. The date of priority is MAY 19, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.56 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, in any combination from the wells or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

Water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).


The quantity of water diverted at the additional two points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain in-line flow meter(s) or other suitable device(s) for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device(s) must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm additional points of appropriation and change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 3, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 7, approving Transfer Application 9944, and supersedes Certificate 81591, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
