The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed ONE ACRE FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND ¼ ACRE FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH THEREAFTER AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO A TOTAL OF 5.0 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE FOR THE SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30.
