CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of END CREEK for IRRIGATION of 1.0 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 227. The date of priority is 1893.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

TWP	RNG	MER	SEC	Q - Q	MEASURED DISTANCES
1 S	38 E	WM	15	SW SW	1246 FEET NORTH AND 3375 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST CORNER OF SECTION 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 20 2012, and recorded in Special Order Volume 85, Pages 941 to 944, approving Transfer Application T-10500. This certificate together with Certificate 87389, supersedes Certificate 33244, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
