## ·CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

POVERTY ACRES INC. 80897 WOLFE LANE HERMISTON OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS, tributary to UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION of 259.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5985. The date of priority is December 31, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.25 cubic feet per second (CFS), being 2.22 CFS from Well 1, 2.63 CFS from Well 3, and 2.70 CFS from Well 5, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm additional points of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 14, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 938, approving Transfer Application 7240 and supersedes Certificate 54562, State record of Water Right Certificates.
