CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KIRPAL LIGHT SATSANG INC.

confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED SPRINGS, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, in FIVE RESERVOIRS, appropriated under Permit 51211, for IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, AND DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Permit R-11367. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 11.455 acre-feet (af), being 2.5 af in Reservoir A, 1.4 af in Reservoir B, 2.0 af in Reservoir C, 5.524 af in Reservoir D, and 0.0307 af in Reservoir E.

The dams are located as follows:

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior to downstream rights.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
