confirms the right to use the waters of UPPER KLAMATH LAKE, a tributary of KLAMATH RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 253.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-41856. The date of priority is MARCH 24, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.11 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
