## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER, a tributary of the WALLOWA RIVER for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 25.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 232.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-38052. The date of priority is MAY 7, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 5.92 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
