 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LON G. WADEKAMPER

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 9.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7358. The date of priority is May 22, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well, AND IS FURTHER LIMITED TO NOT MORE THAN 9.8 ACRE-FEET PER MONTH DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON, TO A MAXIMUM OF 29.4 ACRE-FEET PER SEASON.

The quantity of water appropriated shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old well located as follows: 200 FEET NORTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 7, WITHIN THE SW ¼ NE ¼, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M. (WADEKAMPER WELL).

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

No use of water shall occur unless the flow meter or suitable measuring device is functioning properly.

This certificate is issued to correct an error in the location of the point of appropriation (well) and supersedes Certificate 86375, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
