CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the Rogue Basin for DOMESTIC USE FOR 214 FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWNS OR GARDENS NOT TO EXCEED 1/8 ACRE IN AREA PER FAMILY, AND COMMUNITY SERVICE SUPPLIES TO ONE CAR WASH AREA, ONE LAUNDRY AREA, ONE CLUB HOUSE, AND ONE RESTROOM.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10698. The date of priority is OCTOBER 22, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 333.2 GALLONS PER MINUTE (0.74 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), being 313 gpm for domestic use and 20.2 gpm for community services, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times. The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
