CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MT ANGEL ABBEY BUSINESS OFFICE ST BENEDICT OR 97373

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, tributary to ABIQUA CREEK for IRRIGATION of 124.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5372. The date of priority is MARCH 17, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.50 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

If substantial interference with an existing well having a water right in effect as of the effective date of this change, occurs due to withdrawal of water from the additional point of appropriation, the use of water from the additional point of appropriation may be regulated until or unless the Department approves a plan or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference.

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 26, 1993, at Special Order Volume 47, Page 310, approving Transfer Application 6559, and supersedes Certificate 45199, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
