CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of SARDINE CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The dates of priority are 1859 and 1885. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.25 Cubic Foot per Second (CFS), being 0.17 CFS under the 1859 priority date and 0.08 CFS under the 1885 priority date, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from April 1 through October 31.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 16201, located approximately at:

To the lower boundary of the place of use previously identified under Certificate 16201, located downstream from the described diversion approximately 7800 feet to the south line of the NE SE of Section 5, T36S, R3W, W.M.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 16201, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 27, Page 257 approving Transfer T-10978, and along with Certificate 87515 supersedes Certificate 16201, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
