 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ABIQUA CREEK, tributary to PUDDING RIVER for IRRIGATION of 10.6 ACRES.

The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 12, 1958.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

6 S	1 E	WM	34	SE NW	2220 FEET SOUTH AND 1610 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in the POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 3, 2009, at special order volume 79 page 140, approving Transfer Application T-10831, and supersedes Certificate 31093, State record of Water Rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
