## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 67 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1895.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.12 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs); being 1.12 cfs at Evans Ditch, and 0.68 cfs at POD 3 in any combination, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion, during the irrigation season of each year.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion (Evans Ditch).

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm an Additional Point of Diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 31, 1997 at Special Order Volume 51, Page 51, approving Transfer Application 6743, and supersedes Certificate 136, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
