CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That R. L. Darling

of Fort Klamath, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Anna Creek a tributary of Wood River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 9417 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1929;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.5 cubic feet per second;

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 51, Township 32S, Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E, W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows: 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 51, 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East and 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 33 South, Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East of the Willamette Meridian in Klamath County, Oregon, being a total of 280 acres.

This right is specifically limited to a period of use extending from May 11th to October 1st of each year unless permission is given by the Oregon State Game Commission or the State Engineer to divert water for irrigation earlier than May 11th and such permission shall not be given by the State Engineer in any case unless it is found by him that the diversion before May 11th will not deprive the Oregon State Game Commission of sufficient water for the proper maintenance and operation of its present egg-taking station on Seven Mile Creek.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728, Oregon Laws.
