 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE MACKAY
 DAYVILLE, OR 97825

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 38.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28045. The date of priority is MAY 2, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.93 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the John Day River is more than 30 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 14-0465 and more than 20 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 14-0480 and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 36874, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 30 2012, approving Transfer Application T-11250.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
