CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

N. W. MUMFORD
MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

a right to the use of the WASTE WATER, from the N1/2 of the NE SW, Section 33, T6N R35E and W1/2 of the NW NE, Section 3, T5N R35E, W.M., a tributary of the Walla Walla Watershed for the purpose of IRRIGATION and SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLY of 33.5 acres. The right was perfected under Permit S-6677. The date of priority is September 9, 1924.

The amount of water to which the right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 7503, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 14 2012, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
