CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. S. SHANGLE  
MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

a right to use WASTE WATER, a tributary of Pine Creek and the Walla Walla River, for IRRIGATION of 4.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5537. The date of priority is June 20, 1922.

The amount of water to which the right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used under this right together with the amount obtained for other sources of supply for the same land, shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of once cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes a portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 5086, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 14 2012, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate along with Certificate 86900 supersedes Certificate 5086.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
