CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a right to use WASTE WATER from the N1/2 of the NE1/4 of the NENE of SECTION 3, T5N R35E, WM, a tributary of Walla Walla River Drainage for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 0.7 acre. This right was perfected under Permit S-12905. The date of priority is July 8, 1937.

The amount of water to which the right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used under this right together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-THIRTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall also be limited to the water available at the point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others. The amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other existing right for the same land shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12282, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **AUG 14 2012**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate along with Certificate 86905 supersedes Certificate 12282.
