CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

I. M. PHIPPS
MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

a right to use the waters of the Walla Walla River, a tributary to the Columbia River for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 2.17 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12, Page 9. The date of priority is 1880.

The amount of water to which the right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above described decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes a portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13020, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 14 2012, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes a portion of Certificate 13020.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
