CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES J. NAGELE
1702 SW GOODWIN PLACE
PENDLETON, OR 97801

a right to use WASTE WATER, a tributary of the LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 0.7 acre.

This right was perfected under Permit S-32560. The date of priority is July 28, 1967.

The amount of water to which the right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
6 N	35 E	WM	34	SW SW	400 FEET NORTH AND 1020 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.0375 of one cfs per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	34	SW SW	0.7

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 40943, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **AUG 14 2012**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 40943.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
