CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GREENWOOD PACIFIC INC.  
16480 S ARCHER DR  
OREGON CITY, OR 97045

a right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 0.1 acre.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10496. The date of priority is March 14, 1985. This right is limited to 0.003 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	34	SW SW	800 FEET NORTH AND 920 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cfs (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes a portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 82520, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **AUG 14 2012**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes a portion of Certificate 82520.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
