CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

a right to use the waters of the FORD BRANCH OF THE LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER for FROST PROTECTION on 0.2 acre.

This right was perfected under Permit S-39706. The date of priority is January 22, 1974.

The amount of water to which the right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
5 N	35 E	WM	2	NW NW	670 FEET SOUTH AND 500 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes a portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 55005, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 14 2012, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes a portion of Certificate 55005.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
