## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GORDON C. AND JUDITH D. ROSE 8908 JOHN DAY DR GOLD HILL, OR 97525

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary to the PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 60.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-23796. The date of priority is JULY 28, 1955. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.76 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
