CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, a tributary of SAUM CREEK (TUALATIN RIVER) for IRRIGATION of 4.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6656. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 12, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-00-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. Water shall be acquired from the same basalt aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

If substantial or undue interference with an existing well used under an existing right occurs, and such interference can be shown to result from the change in the way the water right is exercised as authorized herein, the use of the new well allowed under this right shall be regulated to mitigate the interference.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 26, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 87, approving Transfer Application 7457, and together with Certificate 68766, supersedes Certificate 45728, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
