CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROATS WATER SYSTEM INC.
61147 HAMILTON LANE
BEND OR 97702

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 3, WELL 4, WELL 9, AND NEW WELL 10, in the DESCHUTES BASIN for GROUP DOMESTIC AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 13.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1890. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.50 CFS for Group Domestic and 0.16 CFS for supplemental irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation described as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate existing measurement device at New Well 10 and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of appropriation, additional points of appropriation and a change in use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 8, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 503, approving Transfer Application 10979, and supersedes Certificate 86042, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).
