## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KIRPAL LIGHT SATSANG INC. PO BOX 10 UMPQUA OR 97486

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRING 1 AND THE UMPQUA RIVER, tributaries of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 1.34 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 16.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51211. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.02 CFS FROM SPRING 1 FOR IRRIGATION OF 1.34 ACRES AND 0.20 CFS FROM THE UMPQUA RIVER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 16.1 ACRES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior water rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
