CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That George W. Vanaelstine of The Dalles, Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 12 East, Willamette Meridian near the North Fork of Mill Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. U-10 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 22, 1929; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 12 East, W.M.

The use hereunder shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows: 3 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 1 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Wasco County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
